Website Moderator – Brian Mushens (Dartmouth)

I have enjoyed my first full year, and as expected it's been a busy one. I have worked well with Ian on a variety of fronts and we're getting there!

After the development of the privacy policy early in the year, our main task was to move to MailChimp as our email communication platform. This went relatively smoothly and we are now able to communicate with over 300 subscribed members at the click of a button. You may have noticed a couple of differences from the previous system, both of which

are to protect users. A recipient cannot “reply to all” which can be seen as both a benefit and a drawback. Also, to prevent the distribution of malicious software, MailChimp doesn’t allow file attachments, so documents are now hosted on the DGC website.

My WordPress knowledge is improving but not sufficiently to be able to change the look and feel of the website significantly - the wobbly ship logo remains! That said, thanks to contributions from Captain Bob, Vice Dave and Malcolm, I’ve kept up to date with posting tournament and match reports. However, we can’t see how many have been read!

My most pressing task is to update the members’ handbook. I’m making good progress with this but inevitably there will be some errors and likely omissions which I’ll endeavour to rectify over time. We will be moving away from the current flip book to a more dynamic document which will be searchable.

I’m looking forward to taking over the management of the 4BBB knockout competition. This has been very much Malcolm’s baby since its inception, and I’ll do my best to ensure that it has a safe future.
